





Fine Arts

Fine arts is such a unique stream of study which is highly in demand in today's time because of the changing lifestyle and aesthetic values. As the nature of art practice today touch many fields, the Fine Arts courses at Tecnia Institute of Art and Design have been designed combining practical and theoretical knowledge with information of latest development in the world of art.







Music, Dance & Instrument

Both music and dance are essential avenues for preserving cultural heritage. The society's stress on materialism and our personal utilitarian goal detracts us from opting for music as career. However, effective music education can help ameliorate this attitude.

In today's socio-economic scenario, dance and music are not mere performing arts for entertainment, it ensures career opportunities also. Market, economy and life style have changed the musical taste and aesthetic sensibility of the masses. To meet the demand for professionally trained artists based on market economy Institute offers U.G.C. recognized degrees and diplomas under the music dance & instrument faculties.











Bachelors of Fine Arts (BFA)

Level: Degree **Duration:** 4 Years **Eligibility:** 10+2

Upper Age Limit: 26 Years

(*no age bar for female candidates)

The Bachelors of Fine Arts (B.F.A) is a 4 years full time programme comprising of one-year foundation and three years specialization courses. One language (English or Hindi) and a paper on Environmental Study is compulsory in foundation course. The Foundation Course is an intensive one year study at the first year level which is common to the Specializations of Painting, Sculpture, Applied Art, Print making and Visual Communication providing basic training in art and design.

We offer B.F.A. Specialization in Painting, which will be covered in second, third and fourth year of B.F.A. The course comprises the following papers: History of Art, Life Drawing, Pictorial Composition, Portrait Painting. Exhibition is a mandatory part of the course.





Bachelors of Performing Arts (BPA)

Level: Degree **Duration:** 4 Years **Eligibility:** 10+2

Upper Age Limit: 26 Years

(*no age bar for female candidates)

The degree course is a four year regular course comprising of eight semesters. The students receive exposure of the Ragas, Tala, general knowledge of various styles, Gharanas and performances. Along with practical subjects they study musicology and theory in depth.

During the course we focus on 'Riyaz' (regular practice) and performances.






Bachelors of Fashion Designing (B.VOC)

Level: Degree
Duration: 3 Years
Eligibility: 10+2
Age Limit: 26 Years

This three years degree programme builds a strong foundation in terms of design sense, conceptualization, independent research, creative, application and individual artistic expression.

Fashion designing comprises of Dress designing from Party wear to Sportswear, Kidswear to Menswear, Women's formal wear to casual wear and so on. The students are introduced to History of Fashion, Fashion Revolutions and how these have influenced Contemporary Fashion. The entire course takes the student through the depth of Sketching, Stitching, Cutting, Tailoring, Merchandising, Computer-Aided Designing and Fashion Portfolio.





Master in Fine Arts (MFA)

Level: Post Graduate Degree


Duration: 2 Years

Eligibility: B.F.A Required **Upper Age Limit:** 30 Years

(*no age bar for female candidates)

The Master of Fine Art (M.F.A) is a two year, full time programme. Each academic session is divided in 2 semesters. At "Tecnia Institute of Art and Design" the M.F.A course offer an exciting critically engaged programme for emerging artists. The curriculum is based on a combination of theory and professional practices. The programme encourages student to create, present and interpret their work with intellectual rigor and refined skill.

The course comprises the following papers: History of Indian Painting, Western Painting, Creative Composition, Seminar, Exhibition and Viva, Dissertation.





Master of Performing Arts (MPA)

(Vocal Music, Dance, Tabla)

Level: Post Graduate Degree

Duration: 2 Years

Eligibility: B.P.A Required **Upper Age Limit:** 30 Years

(*no age bar for female candidates)

Master of Performing Arts (MPA) is a Postgraduate degree of Vocal Music, Tabla, Kathak & Bharatnatyam dance. The degree is mostly conferred in India after completion of 2 years programme in MPA.

This programme is mainly designed to impart depth knowledge of music through theory and practicals. This can be a dream course for the creative artistic souls who love to perform and also want to have a complete knowledge of the skills.

The students who enrol for Masters in Performing arts, majority of them pursue Ph.D later on if the student does not opt for higher studies they easily manage to earn good money and recognition.



MA (Vocal Music, Tabla, Dance)

Level: Post Graduate Degree

Duration: 2 Years

Eligibility: B.A. Required **Upper Age Limit:** 30 Years

(*no age bar for female candidates)

MA in music is also a Master degree course. Students, who have done BA (Hons) in music, can do MA in Music. It is a two years programme and the course includes a comprehensive and thorough study and practice of music as a discipline at an advanced level.

The students have the option to choose between vocal and instrumental courses.

Similarly MA in Dance can be done by students who can opt kathak or Bharatnatyam Dance based on graduation degree.



Art Appreciation (Painting)

Duration: 2 Years **Level:** Diploma **Eligibility:** 10+2

Upper Age Limit: 26 Years

(*no age bar for female candidates)

This Course is basically meant to inculcate interest for art especially in Indian Painting, targeted to art lovers who want to acquire a general knowledge for better understanding and appreciation of Art within a short time. The course content comprises of Appreciation and History of Indian Painting, History of Modern Art, Portrait Painting, Copy from Old Master and Figurative Composition.







Level: Diploma

The six years diploma course is divided into three major heads of two years each:

These courses aim to provide good performances and mastery in the specific branch of Music, Dance and Instruments.

Vocal Music

The Department is engaged in teaching Hindustani style of vocal music. This department offers unique programme in Hindustani Khayal, Dhrupad and Dhamar. The department also meets the demands of the students who may be interested in neo-classical forms like Thumri, Dadra, Hori or lighter styles like: Geet, Ghazal, Bhajan etc.

Tabla

Department is engaged in teaching and research in Hindustani Percussion Instruments that includes Tabla and Pakhawaj. These courses have been designed to facilitate elaborate training and extensive exposure to the students.

Kathak Dance

The department is successfully boosting up interest for itself in the new generation and trying to be at the zenith of fame.

Bharatnatyam Dance

The Department has succeeded in creating awareness about Bharatnatyam, the most ancient and popular dance form of South India. Music educators cum performers.

Admission Procedure

How to Enroll

- Admission to courses will be made through aptitude test & audition by the Institute at the premises.
- Admission forms are available at the Institute website & at College reception.
- Date & Time of test will be prior informed to the candidate.
- Candidate need to submit Passport size six recent photographs.
- Self-attested photocopies of certificates of all educational qualifications.
- Registration fee of Rs. 1500/- (Fifteen hundred only) has to be paid along with application form, which will be non-refundable.
- On confirmation of Admission the students shall deposit the Admission fee.
- You can visit the premises between 09:00 AM to 04:00 PM on all working days.

Submission of Application

- The fee is payable through Cash/Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque, drawn in favour of 'Tecnia Institute of Art and Design' payable at Delhi.

Entrance Test/Aptitude Test

Admission is subject to clearing of Entrance Test, Group Discussion and Personal Interview conducted by the Institute. The decision of the Admission Committee will be final in all respects.

Students should bring art material (pencil, charcoal, water colour etc.). Paper will be provided by the Institute.

Result

Result will be declared on the next day of the Entrance Test.

Counselling

The counselling session starts in the Institute premises in April/ May from 9:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. for admission to different courses offered by the Institute.

Fee Deposit

Fees* should be deposited within a week after declaration of result.

Refund of Fee

Fees* once deposited will not be refunded in any case.

Withdrawal from College

A student wishing to withdraw his/her name from the Institute must do so formally in writing. He/she is liable to pay all fees and other college dues until his/her name is formally withdrawn. Identity and library cards must be surrendered at the time of the withdrawal, failing which a penalty of Rs. 100 and Rs. 40 will be charged for the loss of Identity Card and each Library Card respectively. In case a student drops out without such a withdrawal, his/her security amount will be forfeited and adjusted towards the dues. No claim for refund will be entertained later.
